Purposed By-Law Changes ARTICLE IV – OFFICER

Sec. 4 – Term of Office

OLD: The Secretary will be elected in the odd years and serve for two years.

NEW: The Secretary will be elected in the odd years and serve for a term of two years. They may seek a second consecutive term.

Sec. 4 – Term of Office

OLD: The Treasurer will be elected in the even years-and serve for two years.

NEW: the treasurer will be elected in the even years and serve for a term of two years. They may see a second consecutive term.

<u>GHIN (Golf handicap index) system</u> is coming up again with the mens league. Ladies league is encouraged to consider getting a GHIN handicap. If you already have membership with number you do not need to join again. We are the only golf course not using the GHIN system. For Sunland members to participate in activities with other golf courses players, they will need a GIN Handicap. If member of Sunland Village does not have a GHIN handicap they will not be able to participate in activities with other courses in the area. Benefits: everyone equal, other courses on gin and do not want to play with players without a gin handicap. Cost depends on number joining. All members encouraged to join the GHIN system. Cost can be added to league dues. App: you have access to all scores.

Hours of Course Ranger: Days and hours Monday through Friday. Rangers are volunteers. They start at 10:00am to 5 pm.

If group does not agree, ball is considered out of bounds/lost ball. Player needs to go back and hit the ball from were the shot originated. One stroke penalty. Ditch not a stroke because man made.
