Provisional ball: Do not know where ball went, can play a provisional ball but must call it a provisional ball. If not called a provisional must use that ball with penalty. If ball found must use found ball. Can hit provisional ball to where you think yours went. If you find ball

Teeing area: Can go back 2 club lengths to hit ball. May stand outside of tee box to hit. Tee markers can not be changed.

Bunkers: Touching sand incidentally is allowed. Permitted to lean on club in bunker but you are not allowed to test the sand. You are not allowed to touch the sand with a practice swing.

If two balls are close together in fairway: can mark ball in_
