

## **Minutes of the December 8, 2022 - Meeting, Sunland Village Men's Golf League**

The meeting was called to order at 9.00 AM by President, Gary Coover. Board Members: Gary Coover, Bob Perius, Keith Haycraft, and Rex Schultze were in attendance, Bob Riggs was absent and excused.

**QUORUM:** A quorum of 36 members were present at the meeting.

**President's Report:** President, Gary Coover, welcomed all, and noted the success of the Home & Home with Sunland Springs.

**Treasurers Report:** Keith Haycraft, Treasurer, reported that as of April 13, 2022, the bank balance was \$1926.33 (balance after pay out for Member-Guest Tournament). Hole-in-One post is empty due to Chuck Mueller's hole-in-one on Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup> - GREAT SHOT – for \$1,808.00. The Home & Home with Sunland Springs was a no cost event – cash-in-cash out. The “Fun Day” cost \$361.00.

**Secretary's Report:** Rex Schultze stated that the November 10, 2022 minutes were posted in the Pro-shop hallway.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- **Pictures of SLV-MGL Members:** Pictures of SLV-MGL members are need. There are now 41 members who do not have their pictures taken and posted in the hallway adjacent to the club meeting room. Members are to sign-up in the pro-shop so Ray Sedey can arrange to get each member's picture taken. New members - if you are a new member and not on the list, sign up for a picture in the pro-shop.
- **GHIN Handicap Sign-up:** Rex Schultze reported that the GHIN handicap system has been established with the Arizona Golf Association (AGA) under the name of “Sunland Village World Handicap System” (SVWHS). The SVWHA is available for use by any golfers (not necessarily SVML members) for personal use to establish a GHIN handicap. The WVVHS is NOT affiliated with the Sunland Village Golf Club, the Sunland Village Men's Golf League (SVMGL) or the Sunland Village Women's Golf League (SVWGL); rather it is begin made available through the SVWHS as a totally separate entity. Players can join before December 31, 2022 for \$35.00 by

going to the AGA website. GHGN members will be responsible for recording their scores into the GHGN system

- **THE SVML WILL CONTINUE TO USE THE CURRENT HANDICAP SYSTEM FOR LEAGUE PLAY AND HOME & HOME EVENTS!!!**
- All SVMGL events are self-funded except “Fun Day” – which are funded through SVMGL dues. No SVMGL funds will be sued for any Home & Home or any other tournament sponsored by the SVMGL whether or not requiring a GHIN handicap.
- Per discussion at the meeting, it was established that the GHIN handicap MAY be required for possible Ryder Cup type events depending on the request of the other club participating and the SVML determination to participate under requirement.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Sunland Springs – Home & Home on December 5th and December 7<sup>th</sup>: Kirk White reported that the Home & Home with Sunland Springs Golf Club went very well. The winners know who they are – and Kirk gave them their money – so the \$\$\$ winners remained anonymous.
- **Beautification Committee:** Bob Perius reported that new trees were planted on the tees of Hole Nos. 4 and 8. Six (6) new planting so desert foliage have been placed in the area on the south side of the clubhouse parking lot – between the sidewalk and the parking lot retaining wall. The watering system for potential planting on the island between Hole Nos. 6 and 7 has now been fixed, and plans are under way for planting in that location. The fountain feature behind Hole No. 4 along Rochester Street remains under consideration, but the potential \$35,000 to \$45,000 cost is a factor; any change to that project as a priority which be addressed at the meeting following the Beautification Tournament on March 18<sup>th</sup>.
- **Golf Professional Report:** Dan Gustafson stated that the Christmas Sale in the Pro-shop will be held on December 14<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 to 7:00 P.M. Dan stated that he would do pairings for Fun Day’s by computer to encourage members to play with those they do not know. Members must sign up to play and for breakfast.
- **Club Manager Report:** Ryan DuBois reported that:

- The Pro-Shop will close on December 24<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 P.M., and will be closed all day on December 25<sup>th</sup> for Christmas. The course will be open for member play on both December 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Pro-Shop and golf course will be open throughout the New Year's holiday.
  - To encourage better grass growth, the green will be top dressed every two or three weeks over the next few months.
  - Looking at a date for the "Cross Country – 9 Hole Tournament" - also called the tournament to see how many people will hit Larry Jochim's house!
  - Roy asked about a 3-club tournament and Ryan DuBois said he would look at that as an event.
- **Club Championship and Awards Banquet:** Rex Schultze reported on preliminary ideas for the Awards Banquet following the Club Championship to be held on March 29<sup>th</sup>; inquiring as to the interest in having a "Casino Night" as entertainment. A show of hands of those in attendance indicated little interest in such an event. Rex request ideas from the club member – none were forthcoming.
- **Coming SVL-MGL Events:** The membership was reminded to the upcoming golf events:
    - YAHTZEE Tournament – January 9<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>; Darrel Rohlf's has again agreed to run the tournament – THANKS DARREL!
    - Ryder Cup Tournament – Fountain of the Sun – January 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.
    - Sunland Village - East – Home & Home – SLV – February 20<sup>th</sup> and February 22<sup>nd</sup> – SLVE.
    - SLVGC Beautification Couples Tournament – March 18<sup>th</sup>.
    - YAHTZEE Tournament – To be determined (Sometime between February 22<sup>nd</sup> and March 5<sup>th</sup>).
    - CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: The SLVML Club Championship will be held March 6<sup>th</sup> through the 15<sup>th</sup>. There will be multiple flights, so everyone can find an avenue for a big WIN!
    - Awards Banquet – March 29<sup>th</sup>.
