- * To move marker on green use putter head to mark... two putter heads if needed
- * If unable to take swing, two club length relief with stroke penalty
- * Effects stance or swing free relief ... curb, ditches
- * Player can determine what is unplayable to them anywhere on the course. Take a stroke and take two club length relief. Can not take out of a hazard.
- * Stance relief: nearest point of complete relief... bn
