

January 8, 2026 Meeting Sunland Village Men's Golf League

Board members Steve Stahr, Dave Sell, Charlie Lucero, Gary Coover and Ray Sedey were in attendance.

Quorum: A quorum of 44 members was present for the meeting.

Call to order: President Steve Stahr called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and welcomed everyone to the meeting. He introduced Greg Ramsdale, candidate for the HOA board, and Greg addressed the membership.

Presidents' Report: Steve asked for volunteers to help with Home and Home. It is \$80 per person and payment is due when signing up for the tournament. You can use your account, check or cash. The goal is 44 players and Don Wick explained the gist of play. The \$80 includes mulligan fees both here and there. We are asking for our members to help with providing beverages for after play here. We are looking at ways to be able to use a credit card to add money to your individual account and credit card fees will be included. Please keep your carts on the cart paths and don't drive with one set of wheels off of the path. When you exit the fairways to the cart path don't use the same path as other carts to help keep the course in good shape. We need candidates for the Men's League Golf Board for next year. If you participate in the daily hole in one and or skin pots sign the sheets. It is being considered to combine the Men's and Ladie's summer league play on Mondays and Thursdays. Fix ball marks on the greens and fill in divots, this is your course. Anyone with a fund-raising idea please bring it to a board member. Please help to prevent damage to range balls by throwing them back on the range if you find them on the course. The individual accounts we are using for payment is not mandatory but it is encouraged for you to use it. There won't be a fun day in February due to the other activities.

Treasurer's Report: Gary Coover reported that the account balance is \$3367.64 in the bank and \$913.05 in the hole in one pot. The individual accounts are in a separate bank account. Chits are not part of this. Presently the individual accounts have \$6893.00 in the bank. There will be another presentation on the new system soon.

Secretary's Report: Ray Sedey reported that last December's meeting minutes had no changes and were posted on the bulletin board.

Committee Reports: Dave Sell reported that work is progressing on the Home and Home tournament and volunteers are needed to help.

Comments by Head Pro, Billy: Billy asked that members try their best to pair up in golf carts to help reduce damage to the golf course. He has been hearing great things about the condition of the golf course and we want to keep it that way. Thanks to Neema for all of the work he has done on setting up the individual accounts.

Old Business: It was suggested to raise Men's League dues to \$40 starting next year. A motion was made to put this on the ballot for our upcoming vote and was moved by Mike Fairbank and seconded by Joe Wilkerson to proceed. The motion was passed by a show of hands.

New Business: Candidates for Men's League Board are needed. Please volunteer and support our league. New board members are not coming in for a specific position. The new board votes on who will have what position.

He asked that anyone participating in the Yahtzee tournament to please fill your score card properly. It was brought up that members pay when they sign up for the home and home or you may not play. It was asked if we can add GHIN payment to our dues. We currently have 47 members in the GHIN system. You can use the GHIN from your home if you are paid up. You do not need to have a GHIN membership to play in the Ryder Cup. Money for repairs to our facilities comes from the Maintenance budget and we are working on ways to improve on getting things fixed.

A motion was made to adjourn and seconded and the meeting adjourned.
