ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Summer League policy:

There was some discussion about out-of-the-park events being open to both 18 and 9-holers. The 9 hole committee will book for 9 hole courses and the 18 hole committee will book for 18 hole courses.

Discussion about options for summer league play:

1. Men & Women tee off together on Monday & Thursday @ 6:30, so that half the course could be sold to public
2. Keep play as is with men on Monday & Wednesday & women on Tuesday & Thursday with the understanding that tee times would be sold during league play

Summer members voted (85%) to keep play as is.

There was very spirited discussion about changing time of play in winter so that 18 & 9-holers would all tee off at 9:30. Brad said the course was full on Tuesday & Thursday & it was not feasible to having 18 & 9-holers all going off at 9:30. However, if the current trend continues (18 hole league usage is about 40-48 players) and (9 hole league usage is about 40-48 players), that would leave 6 open holes on each shotgun start. Those holes can be sold to the public until such time as our membership increases.

There was a vote & members voted by a large majority (75%) to keep times at 8 and 11 during the winter.

Code of Conduct policy:

Any complaints about members not reporting correct scores must be in writing, with signature, and prepared to attend a hearing to present proof. Also, members playing in group should agree on score. If card is signed, it means players have agreed on scores & it should not go any further. No complaints after card is signed.

Cursing is offensive & should not be taking place.

Club Championship will be played March 10, 12 & 17, 2026

Bonnie Deutch reported on 50-25-25 raffle. Total brought in \$267.00; club received \$133.50; Pam Frankhanel & Carol Marshall each got \$66.75.
